

Northampton Eisteddfod Data Privacy Notice

Introduction: The Eisteddfod aims to protect the rights of eisteddfod participants, volunteers and supporters; comply with data protection law and good practice and protect participants from risk of a data breach. In order to operate, Northampton Eisteddfod needs to gather, store and use certain forms of information about individuals.

Key Roles: This policy applies to all committee members that are handling data on behalf of the eisteddfod.

Key roles are:-

Eisteddfod Secretary, Treasurer, Entries' secretary, Stewards' secretaries and Sponsors', Patrons' and Friends' Secretary

Data Held: The Eisteddfod collects data for following purposes:

- To organise and plan the eisteddfod
- Produce the eisteddfod Programme and Certificates
- Keep an historic record of each eisteddfod
- Maintain contact with participants, Sponsors, Patrons & Friends.

The information retained includes Names, Titles, Roles, Postal addresses, Phone numbers, Email addresses and Photographs. Some photographs may be used on our website and for publicity reasons solely with appropriate permission gained.

Entries: The Entries' secretary holds name information for all who enter the eisteddfod and their teachers and amounts paid. She and the **Eisteddfod Secretary** hold mailing list information in spreadsheet and database forms. This information is held on password protected, antivirus/malware protected, secured laptop and desktop PC.

All data is held for a limited period and only when necessary.

Eisteddfod Stewards' secretaries hold name and address information for all who support and assist the eisteddfod. This information is held on password protected, antivirus/malware protected, secured laptop and/or desktop PC.

Sponsors', Patrons' and Friends' Secretary holds name and address information and amounts paid by those who support The Eisteddfod. The information is used to send notices about subscriptions and to send prospectus and programme to those who request them.

Licensing Information. Relevant information of some children under 18 is collected and held securely for one year, in accordance with and for the *Child performance and activities licensing legislation in England – Gov.UK*

Consent: There will be a box on each entry form giving permission for the information on the form to be used as outlined above. **We cannot accept an entry unless this box has been ticked.**
